

Tips for mentors



- Solve any logistical/access problems prior to the beginning of the mentorship
- Have a clearly defined project that has a clear goal which can be accomplished in 12 weeks
 - Side quests are good too! Small wins build confidence.
- Meet with your mentees at least weekly
- Have mentees document what they've done each week, this becomes a valuable resource for everyone for mid-terms, final projects, etc.



Tips for mentees



- It's a very competitive program, tailor your application to the project
- Visit the project before final mentorship decisions are made
 - Join a meeting and introduce yourself
 - Reply to a code review, or issue
- Don't be afraid to ask your mentor for help and guidance, especially if you're struggling, that's what they're there for
- Notify your mentor if you feel like you're getting off-track so they can help, or adjust project parameters
