

What's an OSPO?



Open Source Program Office (https://ospodefinition.org/)

...so, for IBM Z & LinuxONE?

- Maintains relationships with open source projects
- Provides resources (VMs, documentation) and eases contributions (helps with bug reports, other issues)
- Runs initiatives like the Open Mainframe Project Linux Distributions Working Group & Software Discovery Tool
- Helps manage internal organization, strategy, and issue resolution across Linux, z/OS, z/VM...

I also answer "Does this run on IBM Z?" A lot.

- From <u>Package Distro Search</u>: SLES, RHEL & Ubuntu
- <u>Maintained in-project</u>: AlmaLinux, Debian, Fedora, openSUSE, Rocky Linux
- IBM Validated Software List for SLES, RHEL & Ubuntu
- IBM Z and LinuxONE Container Registry









IBM z/OS

- Open Mainframe Project software
 - including Ambitus projects
- Open source software from Rocket Software
- Manually sourced "general" list, including from github.com/IBM/IBM-Z-zOS/

Software Discovery Tool helps match developers with the best open source software that meets their needs. Developers can search through open source software for zArchitecture/s390x for any Z operating system from any source, any repo, anywhere, in one place.






Voila!



Where else? Check the source!



Go to the open source project website.

- Is there a binary in their downloads?
 - Or "hidden" somewhere on their Git repository?
- Are there installation instructions for IBM Ż or LinuxONE?
- Ask them directly
 - Not there yet? Asking helps projects know there's an appetite for it.





Where else? Talk to vendors!



Talk to ecosystem vendors.

 Several companies in our ecosystem maintain open source packages

I'm from IBM, so I know we have things like the IBM Open Enterprise Foundation for z/OS & a few tools repositories that are shared among developers who are in the know





Where else? Ask your community!



Ask other mainframers.

- At events
- On mailing lists / listservs / forums
- On chat servers





I'm not sure what I'm looking for...



Know what you want to do, but not what software?

Helpful search terms to append to your search:

- Open source
- IBM Z or LinuxONE
- \$390x (this is how open source projects refer to the architecture)
- zArchitecture
- Operating system (Linux? z/OS? z/VM?)

Example search: open source relational database for LinuxONE





Is it supported?



"Support" can mean a lot of things!

Most open source software is provided as-is from the project.

Vendors can offer varying levels of support, so work with your vendor or a vendor developing the software you're looking at to identify what is offered and what your organization needs.
